## 13 DAY TRAVEL ITINERARY

### DAY 01 NEW YORK / ATHENS

Departure from New York to Athens.

### DAY 02 ATHENS

Upon arrival in Athens, in a group, we will head to the hotel with dinner included and spend the night.

### DAY 03 ATHENS / CORINTH / MYCENAE / ATHENS

We will meet the guide and driver at the hotel to drive us to Corinth. We will have a tour of the Corinth Canal, ancient Corinth, the excavations and the Bimah. Also Mycenae, the powerful kingdom of ancient Greece and a military fortress. We will see the Tombs of the Hive, the Treasury of Atreus. We will visit the remains of the ancient city, including the Lioness Gate, the tomb of Agamemnon and the Palace. Return to Athens for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 04 ATHENS / PIRAEUS / MYKONOS

This morning we will be taken to Piraeus and board our cruise in the Aegean Sea. It is said that with three days in the Aegean you really experience what Greece is and has been in its history, as well as a great respect for the majestic and stunning Aegean islands that are a gift from God. The first port we will arrive at is Mykonos, an island with beautiful beaches, hidden caves, bright white houses, narrow streets and windmills all over the island. Mykonos is also known for its 365 churches, spread all over the island. We will return to the cruise ship for dinner and while resting for the night, we will continue our sea tour.

### DAY 05 PATMOS / KUSADASI (EPHESUS)

We will arrive early at the Port of Kusadasi (Ephesus) and upon disembarking, we will board our bus to head to the ancient city of Ephesus and enjoy a walking tour of one of the most impressive excavated cities in the world. We will visit the Odeon (concert hall), Trajan's fountain, the steam baths of Schostika, Hadrian's Temple and latrines, Celsus' Library and the great Theatre of Ephesus where the apostle Paul preached. We will return in our bus along the Arcadia road where Mark Antony and Cleopatra traveled as newlyweds. We will return to our cruise ship for a short trip to the island of Patmos to visit the monastery of St. John where we will see the original manuscript of his gospel. We will also visit the grotto of the Apocalypse where we will see the silver niches in the walls that were the pillow and shelves used as a desk by the author of the book of Revelation, as well as the three cracks made by the voice of God. We will return to our cruise ship for dinner and overnight on the way to Crete.

### DAY 06 CRETE / SANTORINI

We will arrive early at the Port of Heraklion (Crete) for a tour of Knossos, the capital of the prehistoric civilization of Minoan. In addition, we will enjoy a tour of the excavations of King Minos' palace and its surroundings. We will return to our cruise ship for a short trip to Santorini. We will go up by cable car to the highest part of the villa and we will have a spectacular view of the Mediterranean Sea. We will spend the night traveling to Piraeus.

### DAY 07 ATHENS

In the morning we will tour Athens which includes the Acropolis, the Hill of Mars, one of the most important preaching of the Gospel of Paul during his stay in Athens during his second missionary journey (Acts 17; 16-34), was where he addressed the religious idolatry of the Greeks. We will visit the Parthenon with the famous Museum, the Temple of Zeus, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the Agora, we will see the ruins of the ancient market where Socrates questioned about understanding the meaning of life. We will see the changing of the guard in Syntagma Square. We will enter the Plaka neighborhood and the Royal Palace. The rest of the day is free. Dinner and overnight.

### DAY 08 METEORA

We will arrive in Piraeus this morning. Then we will leave for Meteora and see the Byzantine monasteries integrated into the 1,500 feet high cliffs, this being one of the most impressive panoramic views we will have and dating back to the fourteenth century when monks sought refuge in these places.

## DAY 9 BERE A / THESSALONIKI

We will visit Berea, where Paul preached in the synagogue and continue from there to Thessaloniki, which is the largest city in northern Greece, we will visit the Museum with the famous "Treasures of Vergina", Byzantine churches and Roman ruins. We will continue touring the city, we will visit the ancient church of Hagia Sophia, the White Tower of Thessaloniki, which is a relic of the walls of the Byzantine era. We will contemplate the Roman Rotunda of Galerio. We will visit the Arno Poli neighborhood. Mass at the Immaculate Conception. Dinner and overnight in Thessaloniki.

## DAY 10 KAVALA / PHILIPPI

This morning we will go to Kavala, where Paul arrived with his disciples Timothy and Silas. Luke, the evangelist, came here from Troas. We will see the Roman aqueduct and the ruins of the Acropolis. We will continue to Philip, where Paul preached his first sermon and baptized the first Christians on European soil. We will see the Acropolis, the Market and the crypt that dates back to Roman times, and is believed to have served as a prison for St. Paul. We will return to Thessaloniki for dinner and overnight.

## DAY 11 ISTANBUL

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Istanbul. Upon arrival, celebrate Mass at the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit followed by a full-day tour of Istanbul, including Topkapi Palace, the Imperial Palace of the Ottoman Sultans, Hagia Sophia, one of the great wonders of world architecture built in 6 B.C. by Emperor Justinian, the Blue Mosque, The interior decoration with blue-green tiles is unique in the world with its 6 minarets. We will continue to the Byzantine Hippodrome,

where chariot races were held in honor of the Byzantine emperors, the Chora church after Hagia Sophia, the most important Byzantine monument in Istanbul and finally the Grand Bazaar: the largest souk in the world, heart of the magic of Istanbul with more than 4,000 shops. Dinner and overnight in Istanbul.

## DAY 12 BOSPHORUS / ISTANBUL

Depart from the hotel for a full-day tour of the Bosphorus and Asia. After lunch, we will cross to the Asian side to visit Camlica Hill and tour the Beylerbeyi Palace. This was a summer residence of the Ottoman sultans with its magnificent gardens. Return to Istanbul for dinner and overnight.

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## The Tour Price Includes:

**Air Transportation:** Airfare is based on special contract agreements with various international airlines and include certain restrictions and deadlines. These fares are subject to cancellation penalties, and once tickets are issued, they are **NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE AND CANNOT BE USED TOWARDS FUTURE TRAVEL**. Please refer to our CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY below. Airfare and tour prices are based on prices effective as of **JANUARY 1, 2026** and are subject to change without notice.

**Surface/Land Transportation:** All surface/land transportation described in the itinerary will be provided by modern motor coach, designed for highway travel. Groups will be met and transferred upon arrival and departure.

**Hotels:** We only use first-class hotels. Hotel accommodations are based on double occupancy (2 per room). We reserve the right to substitute hotels of similar quality for those specified in the itinerary.

**Single Room Supplements:** If you would like a single room, there is an additional cost of **\$1,300.00** that will be added to the tour price. Single rooms are limited and will be reserved on a first come first serve basis. If you request a roommate and none is available, you will be considered a "forced single," and charged one half (½) of the Single Room Supplement cost.

**Meal Plan:** Meal plans include two (2) meals per day, breakfast and dinner, with timing depending on the itinerary. Taxes and service charges normally appearing on restaurant bills are included in the tour price for these meals. **A list of any and all dietary requests or food allergies must be emailed to [cathy@inspirationaltoursinc.com](mailto:cathy@inspirationaltoursinc.com) for hotel / airline accommodation at least seven (7) days before departure.** We cannot guarantee any dietary accommodations but will make all efforts to secure special dietary requests. In the event airlines or hotels are unable to accommodate dietary requests, you will be responsible for your meals; it is the individual's responsibility to choose appropriate foods while on the tour. Unused meals will NOT be reimbursed.

**Baggage:** Inspirational Tours, Inc. restricts all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage (max. 50 lbs.) and one (1) carry-on (max. 18 lbs.). **All passengers should check with the airline for up-to-date baggage weight/dimension information and restrictions, which are subject to change at any time before departure.**

**Airport Taxes and Fuel Surcharges:** are included in the tour price and are subject to change.

**The Tour Price Does Include:** Tips to guides, porters, headwaiters, and drivers.

**The Tour Price Does Not Include: *Tips On Board The Cruise.*** Expenses related to issuance/renewal of passports, laundry, mineral waters, wine & liquor, after-lunch/dinner tea, coffee, or food not included in the meal plan above; additional baggage; expenses of carriages, guides, sightseeing or other services other than those specifically mentioned as included in the itinerary; insurance for baggage or personal trip or health insurance; all items of a personal nature, in addition to those not listed above as being included in the tour price.

**Booking Conditions: Deposits and Payment: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person,** payable via cash, check or money order, is required at the time of registration. No registration will be processed without a deposit. Invoices for final balances are issued at or near 90 days before departure. Full and final payment is due 60 days before departure. Registrations received within 90 days of departure require payment in full. If there is any outstanding balance by the Final Payment due date listed on your invoice, all travel services will be subject to automatic cancellation and cancellation fees will apply. A service reinstatement fee may be added to your invoice and must be paid in advance in order to apply for reconfirmation of services. **WE ONLY ACCEPT CASH, CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS FOR THE REGISTRATION FEE.** Payment by credit card is accepted ONLY for final balances or payments towards final balances; all credit card payments will be assessed a **3% non-refundable** convenience fee, which will be added to the total amount being charged.

**Cancellations and Refund Policy:** All cancellations **MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING VIA FAX, E-MAIL OR U.S. MAIL.** The date of the cancellation request is the date used for purposes of any assessed cancellation fees. Please note that some Registration Fees are NON-REFUNDABLE as stated on the Registration Form. Cancellation fees (as to any monies paid over the deposit for a tour with a non-refundable deposit) depend on the timing of the cancellation request, and are as follows: request received between time of registration and up to 59 to 45 days prior to departure—cancellation fee of **50%** of tour cost; request received 44 days or less prior to departure through date of departure—assessed **100%** of the tour cost (air and land, and any deviation fees) as the cancellation fee. Additional charges/fees for deviations and/or upgraded seats may require full payment at time of booking/confirmation, and may be non-refundable; **if a non-refundable air ticket has been issued prior to receiving notice of a cancellation request, you will be 100% responsible for those fees, in addition to the cancellation penalties listed above.** Package cancellation fees include airfare. Once airfare is purchased, either at time of booking, including but not limited to, deviations or seat upgrade requests, or at time of full payment, airline tickets will be issued and are always subject to a 100% penalty. Once full payment is received, Inspirational Tours, Inc. will issue airline tickets, which are non-refundable. if the request requires payment at the time of confirmation, this must be paid by the passenger at the time requested, and may be non-refundable. **ALL deviation or seat upgrade requests must be made in writing, at least 90 days prior to your departure date.**

**Tour Prices:** All tour prices quoted for transportation and land arrangements in this tour are based on rates, (including foreign exchange rates), in effect at the time of the original tour agreement with your tour host and Inspirational Tours, Inc. and are subject to increase without notice prior to departure. **NOTE:** Our tours are based on a minimum number of participants. We reserve the right to cancel or reschedule any tour for any reason including insufficient participants, or events beyond our control. Any cancellation will be advised at the soonest date possible. Validity date on passports must be for at least six (6) months after the date of return of the tour as per the tour dates, or any deviation request.** If we do not receive a copy of your current passport, the information you provide on your Registration Form will be used for ticketing purposes. If ANY information provided (name, date of birth, etc.) does not match what is on your passport, you may be subject to penalties or fees for corrections to airline tickets, and/or may be denied boarding by the airline. Any name change, including minor spelling corrections, may require reservations to be canceled and re-booked. Reservations will then be subject to availability and pricing at the time of re-booking; any increase in airfare will be borne by the passenger.
